Wednesday, August 14th - NO SCHOOL!!!

Thursday, August 15: Location KC Hall (K-8 Only)

7:30-8:00 Student drop off at the KC Hall. We will have AM bus service on this day.

8:00-11:00 Whole school presentations and community building

11:00 Dismissal (students picked up at KC Hall; no PM bus service)

Friday, August 16: Location KC Hall (K-8 Only)

7:30-8:00 Student drop off at the KC Hall. We will have AM bus service on this day.

8:00-3:00 Students sorted into Houses, House meetings & activities

Lunch will be provided by the KC Hall (Cheeseburger, Mac and Cheese, and Fresh Fruit)

Students can bring a cold lunch if necessary.

3:00 Dismissal at KC Hall. We will have PM bus service on this day.

Thursday & Friday are NON-UNIFORM days. They may play outside, so make sure they have appropriate clothing and shoes. The 8th graders will receive specific instructions about how they are to dress for these 2 days. The students DO NOT need to bring school supplies or bookbags these 2 days. They only need to bring a water bottle with their name on it.

Please follow the maps for drop-off and pick-up. Students will be dropped off at the front door. Pick-up will be just like it is at school. We will have the cars line up in rows. When all students are dismissed and in cars, we will release the cars one row at a time.
